Establishing a Corporate Foundation at Nevada Community Foundation

What are they?

A Corporate Foundation at the Nevada Community Foundation allows you and those you name to recommend grants to charitable organizations, with the flexibility to change the organizations you support through the years.

What are the benefits?

SIMPLICITY

You establish a fund by signing a simple document and making an irrevocable gift of cash, securities, or other assets. You choose the fund name and designate advisors.

FLEXIBILITY

You recommend grants to any qualified charitable organization at any time of the year you wish. The Foundation reviews your recommendations and, if all is in order, makes grants to the charitable organizations on your behalf.

PROFESSIONAL PHILANTHROPIC EXPERTISE

Our sole “business” is philanthropy. Whether your charitable interests are local or global, we provide expert, strategic advice for your investment in the causes you care about.

MAXIMUM CHARITABLE TAX DEDUCTION

Your initial gifts to create a fund – and subsequent gifts to support it – receive the maximum tax benefits allowed by law. In addition to cash, the Foundation accepts gifts of securities, real estate, and other personal property, which may help you avoid capital gain taxes on appreciated assets.

IT'S GOOD FOR BUSINESS

Establishing a corporate foundation helps you increase your visibility in the community, foster a loyal customer base and rally your employees. In short, it adds to your bottom line, while you maximize the tax and budget aspects of your company's philanthropy and organize your corporate giving under one structure.



How much does it cost?

Unlike a private foundation, which can cost from \$3,000-\$15,000 to establish, there is no cost to establish a corporate foundation at Nevada Community Foundation and our annual fee is the greater of \$250.00 or approximately 1% of the fair market value of your fund, plus 2% of all distributions, considerably less than the cost of running a private foundation. Additionally, there is no minimum gift to establish a named, corporate foundation at the Nevada Community Foundation.
