About the Bill Walters Las Vegas Golf Hall of Fame Scholarship

The mission of the Las Vegas Golf Hall of Fame is to celebrate and bring awareness to players, administrators, benefactors, groups, instructors, teams and other worthy golfers who have served the game of golf in Las Vegas in a positive and meaningful way, whether through performance on the course, volunteerism, financial support, promotion, or other dedicated service. Beginning in 1991, new members have been inducted into the Las Vegas Golf Hall of Fame, annually. Beautiful displays, tracing the history of Las Vegas golf and the accomplishments of the Hall of Fame inductees are exhibited at the Las Vegas National Golf Clubhouse at 1911 E. Desert Inn Rd. and are open to the public, daily.

Local landowner and golf course developer, Mr. Bill Walters, is President of the Walters Group and presently owns the Bali Hai Golf Course. At the time of his induction into the Las Vegas Golf Hall of Fame in 2013, he announced a substantial donation to establish the new Bill Walters Las Vegas Golf Hall of Fame Scholarship, which will benefit many local high school golfers over the years. His contribution to local youth is widely admired and greatly appreciated!

2023 Scholarship Guidelines & Application

The Las Vegas Golf Hall of Fame (LVGHOF) annually offers scholarships to Clark County high school seniors. The scholarship fund is established by donations from individuals in the community. The first major endowment is from Mr. Bill Walters. Recipients must plan to attend an accredited community college, college, university, trade, or technical school. Those applicants who have received a full scholarship to any college or university are not eligible for this scholarship. Those applicants who have been recruited by a college must check with their respective coaches and inform them of the amount of this scholarship before accepting it.

Application Requirements

Each applicant must complete a TYPED scholarship application, which will include the following:

- A. A fully completed application, signed by the applicant and the parent or guardian
- B. A fully completed report, signed by an official from the applicant's high school
- C. A school transcript
- D. An essay by the applicant in the format outlined in the application
- E. If selected to receive a scholarship, you must provide to the Nevada Community Foundation the following materials:
 - Proof of enrollment for the 2023 fall semester, which must be received in order for funds to be disbursed.
 - Subsequently, an official college transcript for each semester's grades, which must be received by the Nevada Community Foundation in order for funds to be disbursed for upcoming semesters.

Eligibility Criteria

Any Clark County high school senior who, during high school, has participated in a junior golf program, tournaments or a high school golf team and who will graduate from an accredited high school during spring, 2023, may apply for this scholarship. Criteria for selecting recipients include:

- A. Cumulative, Weighted Grade Point Average, Plus Bonus Points
- B. Honors, AP or IB Classes
- C. SAT or ACT scores
- D. Amount of involvement in school activities (i.e., sports, clubs, class officers, etc.)
- E. Amount of involvement in community service (i.e., church, volunteering, Boy Scouts, non-profits, etc.) and/or employment.
- F. Written Essay
- G. Financial Need
- H. Mandatory In-person INTERVIEW with Scholarship Committee (tentatively scheduled for early June)

Generally, students who receive this scholarship have five years from the date of their high school graduation to have used their scholarship funds. However, students who postpone or interrupt their college enrollment to serve in the military, Peace Corp, religious or other service activities, or are employed to improve their financial condition, have up to four additional years from the date of their high school graduation to have used their scholarship funds upon written notification to the Nevada Community Foundation.

All applications must be TYPED and received by 4:00 PM, March 21, 2023.

Nevada Community Foundation

The Nevada Community Foundation, a 501(c) 3 public foundation founded in 1988, administers a collection of charitable funds to benefit our community. The Nevada Community Foundation administers the Las Vegas Golf Hall of Fame Scholarship fund for the Hall of Fame.

Review Process

The Nevada Community Foundation and the LVGHOF will review all applications and, ultimately, the LVGHOF will select the scholarship recipient.

Distribution & Renewal

Scholarships are for \$10,000.00, at the rate of \$2,500 per year, and are renewable for up to four years or eight semesters and will be paid in the following manner: half of the scholarship the first semester and half of the scholarship the second semester. These funds will be paid directly to the post-secondary institution at which the recipient is enrolled. Recipients must maintain a 2.5 GPA and full-time status in order to remain eligible. Evidence of GPA and enrollment status at a post-secondary institution must be submitted to the Nevada Community Foundation in order for funds to be distributed.
